ANNUAL REPORT OF SCHOLARSHIP OF 15 PUPILS IN THE DIOCESE OF MAMFE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024/ 2025

Dear Saint John African Work Group,

We are pleased to submit this annual report for the 15 scholarships awarded to our pupils in some Catholic primary schools within the Diocese of Mamfe under the close supervision of CARITAS Mamfe for the academic year 2024/ 2025. This report highlights the academic progress of our pupils, financial accountability, and impact of your generous support. Thanks very much for your support to our children, for the past three years and entering the forth year

ACADEMIC PROGRESS:

All the pupils demonstrated significant academic progress throughout the year. According to their progress report cards for the three terms which make up the academic year, 13 of them excelled in their studies, while 2 of them were promoted on trial basis. Scan copies of some of their report cards are attached to this report. The new academic year 2025/2026 begins next month September 2025.

FINANCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY

The total grant of 1500 euros for this academic year as the last one was utilized effectively to support the pupils. Receipts for the payment of fees and purchase of basic school materials are attached to this report. As from the report of last year it was reported that school fees was to be increased as from this year from between 30,000frs and 40,000frs. It was effected from this

academic year. For their other school basic needs, we were able to provide them each with a school bag with its contents of: Class Reader, workbooks, Our Way to God according to their classes for Religious studies, and other text books which were of upmost necessity. The

breakdown of expenses is as follows:

School fees: 529,600FRS (53.83 % of total grant)

➤ Basic School materials: 444,500FRS (45.17% of total grant)

IMPACT

The scholarship program has had a profound impact on the lives of our pupils. Your support

has enabled them to access quality education, improve their academic performance, and

develop essential skills. Pictures of the children in class are attached to this report, showcashing

their enthusiasm and engagement in learning.

SOME CHALLENGES AND SUGGESTIONS

1. We will make sure that we give a succinct report every term, and the success stories of

the children as we did and include them in our quarterly bulletin which we are starting

soon. That was not done this year and it made things difficult, everything has been put

in place as we prepare to start the academic year 2025/2026.

2. We still have a number of children who are unable to pay their school fees, especially

some who were recently displaced from their villages from Akwaya by the Fulani

attack on the Cameroon military and who are now based in Mamfe and villages around.

CONCLUSION

We express our heartfelt gratitude to the Saint John African Work Group for their generousity

and commitment to supporting education in the Diocese of Mamfe. Your investments in these

young minds have a lasting impact on their future and contribute to the development of their

community. We look forward to continuing our partnership and exploring ways to expand the

scholarship program.






